# Exclusion of EYFSP data from Analyse School Performance (ASP)

Following the reforms to the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) and changes to the administration and moderation of EYFSP data, DfE has taken the decision that the EYFSP will no longer be included in Analyse School Performance (ASP) after May 2022. Ofsted have similarly decided to remove the EYFSP from its Inspection Data Summary Report (IDSR).

EYFSP data will continue to be published at national and local authority level via a statistical release to give an overall picture of child development. Pupil level EYFSP data will also continue to be made available within the Get Information About Pupil service (formally Key to Success).



### Percentage achieving the expected standard or higher in reading




#### Percentage achieving greater depth in reading

#### Percentage achieving the expected standard or higher in writing



### Percentage achieving greater depth in writing


