'The repetitive, intentional hurting of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an imbalance of power. Bullying can be physical, verbal or psychological. It can happen face-to-face or online'.

As part of our work on anti-bullying we also had a full day of playground games workshops for the children. Mr Massey from Playground Playtimes, worked with each class and trained some of our Year 5 and 6 pupils to be playground leaders. We look forward to setting up the games the children learnt in school to use in the playground.


