
Parents Evening Update

Parents Evening in March will now take place on Tuesday 26th March 2024 from 2pm - 8pm, this is due to a clash with church services on the original date. We are also pleased to inform that our new system will be fully operational from after half term and will be accessed via the school website.

We have had two parents trial the system and they felt it was very easy to use and gave good feedback.

On our return to school on Monday 26 February 2024, every child will come home with an envelope, enclosed in the envelope is a letter confirming how you can gain access to the parents evening booking page along with a student key. It is important that you make a note of your student key and do not lose it, this key allows you to finalise your parents evening booking. Each child has their own key and one key cannot be used for more that one child.

The key will change each September as your child moves up a year group and this will be passed to you with the student update form going forward.



Thursday 7th March 2024

This World Book Day, the theme is 'reading for pleasure' and this is an ideal that we try to instil in the children at Clifton All Saints Academy.

We are fully aware that there is a cost of living crisis at the moment so we will not be asking children to dress up. However, should your child wish to decorate a t-shirt with a book theme, they are welcome to.

In school, we will be celebrating the day by asking the children to take part in some of the following activities:-

- work with other year groups to listen to/read stories
- Take part in a book related scavenger hunt.
- Join in with a quiz appropriate to their age group
- Blind read books will be wrapped up in brown paper with only the blurb to read. Children choose a book based purely on the blurb
- Design a book character for their own story
- Dramatise the class text
- Spend time simply looking at books with their friends.

The School Council will be running a design bookmark competition, based on their favourite book or book character. Children can work on their entries over half term and bring them in on or before World Book Day.

We always love World Book Day at Clifton All Saints Academy and can't wait for this year.
