

Thursday 7 March 2024

This World Book Day, the theme is 'reading for pleasure' and this is an ideal that we try to instill in the children at Clifton All Saints Academy.

We are fully aware that there is a cost of living crisis at the moment so we will not be insisting that children dress up. However, should your child wish to decorate a t-shirt with a book theme, they are welcome to or wear a costume to school they are welcome to.

In school, we will be celebrating the day by asking the children to take part in some of the following activities:-
