
School Meal Charge Increase and Summer Menus

From April 2024, the cost of a school meal for children in KS2 (Juniper, Maple, Olive and Palm) will increase from £2.41 per meal per child to £2.53 per meal per child.

This increase is due to an increase from the provider in the price of a school meal.

This will take affect from our return on Tuesday 16 April 2024 with the increase showing on ParentPay on our return.

We are also pleased to confirm that the lunch menus for the summer term have now arrived and can be viewed below. These should now all be available on ParentPay and will be uploaded to the website before the start of the summer term. If your child has allergies and is on one of the allergy free menus, this will have been sent to you via email.








Whole School Swimming
